**Cafod support in Ukraine** Cafod is supporting a mass distribution project. They are already supplying regular food baskets to 21,000 people. A team of cycle couriers are part of this project. One of the coordinators saw her friend was paralysed and he needed someone to bring him food. Others were isolated with no basic necessities. So she offered to deliver food to him on her bicycle and so an idea was born. The bike couriers are now feeding more than 700 people! "As bicycle volunteers we are united by a common goal to help. We are alive and that is enough to be happy." This is just one example of how your donations are supporting local people.
