<u>First Holy Communion Programme:</u> Application forms are available now for our First Holy Communion Programme 2025/26, leading to the celebration of First Holy Communion next year. If your child is in <u>Year 3</u> at school or aged 7 or over and has not yet made their First Holy Communion, then please obtain an application form available at the back of Church. The closing date for registering for the Programme is <u>Monday 27th October</u>. Those not attending weekly Mass, at least from the time of application, will not be eligible for the subsequent classes or to make their First Holy Communion, as this is a Diocesan expectation.

November the Month of the Holy Souls The month of November is dedicated to the Holy Souls in Purgatory. The Church commemorates all her faithful children who have departed from this life, but have not yet attained the joys of heaven. St. Paul warns us that we must not be ignorant concerning the dead, nor sorrowful, "even as others who have no hope ... For the Lord Himself shall come down from heaven ... and the dead who are in Christ shall rise.

<u>If you would like to offer Holy Mass for your loved ones</u> during November, please use the envelopes provided at the back of Church, along with the list of names and your offering if you wish. The list of names will then remain on the altar throughout the month of November. (The Holy Masses will continue throughout the year under the intention of Holy Souls).

We will visit the cemetery on Sunday 2nd November at 3.00 pm. We will meet at the Cemetery entrance on Kilburn Road and begin with the Holy Rosary for those buried there and elsewhere, also to bless the graves of our loved ones.
