Safeguarding As part of the ongoing procedures in our Diocesan safeguarding process, it is now necessary for us to keep a record of all our volunteers in the central Safeguarding office. This form is for all volunteers who do not require a DBS - this means: readers, welcomers, flower ladies, cleaners, Sunday/Wednesday tea/coffee servers, money collectors (during Holy Mass), money counters, gardeners, maintenance care, altar servers, first aiders, fire wardens and anyone else who volunteers at St Joseph's RC Church. This will be a one-off exercise and we appreciate it is a time-consuming task. **It is a requirement to meet the standards outlined by the Catholic Safeguarding Standards Agency to which the Diocese will soon be quality assured and audited.** Maria will email the form to those who require it and copies will also be available in the Church porch. World Day for Grandparents The Apostolic Penitentiary has announced that Pope Francis has granted a Plenary Indulgence for the faithful who take part in the Third World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly. Cardinal Kevin Joseph Farrell, Prefect of the Dicastery for the Laity, Family, and Life, has requested that a Plenary Indulgence be granted to Catholics taking part in the upcoming Third World Day for Grandparents and the Elderly, which was instituted by Pope Francis. The World Day will be celebrated on Sunday 23rd July under the theme "His mercy is from age to age" (Luke 1:50).

Conditions for gaining the plenary indulgence are:

- the plenary indulgence will be granted to grandparents, the elderly, and all faithful who participate in the solemn celebration presided over by the Pope in St. Peter's Basilica, as well as to all those who attend Mass in various parts of the world.
- the indulgence is subject to the usual conditions of sacramental Confession, reception of the Eucharist, and prayer for the intentions of the Holy Father.

A plenary indulgence offers remission of the temporal punishment due to sins already forgiven, which can be applied to oneself or to the souls in Purgatory. The Apostolic Penitentiary extends the same Plenary Indulgence to those who dedicate significant time to visit - either in-person or by virtual means of communication - their elderly brothers and sisters who are in need or facing difficulties, such as the sick, abandoned, and those with disabilities. For people who are unable to leave their homes due to serious reasons, spiritual participation in Mass celebrated for the World Day through prayer, offering their sufferings, and joining in the broadcasts of the Pope's various celebrations will also grant them the opportunity to obtain a plenary indulgence. However, the indulgence requires that the faithful maintain detachment from sin and intend to fulfil the three usual conditions as soon as possible.
